APPLICATION INFORMATION 2026

DuPage County JATC will be accepting applications **EVERY TUESDAY** through September 30, 2025 for the class that will start in 2026.

You must **APPLY IN PERSON** with a Driver's License and your application fee. Our office location is 28600 Bella Vista Parkway, Suite 1500, Warrenville, IL 60555. Hours for applications are **8:00 - 12:00** in the morning or **1:00 - 4:00** in the afternoon.

There are two training programs available: Commercial Electrician and Telecommunications Electrician.

APPLICATION FEE: One program = \$20.00. Two programs =\$25.00.
Only cash or money order will be accepted for payment.

An Aptitude Test will be given in November 2025 to those with completed applications. The Aptitude Test is two parts: Part I is Algebra. Part II is Reading Comprehension. Test scores range from 1-9. Your score must be a 4 or higher in order to be interviewed in January or February 2026.

After the interview, your name will be placed on an eligibility list. Selection from that list will be determined by the number of job openings. Work will begin in spring 2026. Classes will start in fall 2026.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

(Application Period: Tuesdays Only - October 2024 - September 2025)

Please read all instructions carefully!

I understand that it is my responsibility to provide all of the following information. I further acknowledge that I must **submit all required documents to the JATC by October 31, 2025.**

YOU MUST SUBMIT ITEMS 1-4:

1. Make a copy of your valid Driver's License. If you are driving on a ticket, submit a copy of the ticket AND State I.D.
2. Make a copy of your birth certificate (minimum of 17 years of age).
3. Provide OFFICIAL transcript(s) for high school AND post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
4. If not already provided on OFFICIAL transcripts submitted, provide evidence of successful completion of one full year of high school Algebra I or one post high school Algebra I equivalent. (Minimum "C" average required for Commercial (Inside) and Telecommunication programs.)

Letters of recommendation, personal merit citations, military training as listed on a DD-214, achievement awards, etc. may also be provided. These items must be received by October 31, 2025.

- Photocopied transcripts, outdated transcripts, transcripts identified as unofficial, or transcripts in unsealed envelopes, WILL NOT be accepted.
- Faxed documents will not be accepted.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED!**PLEASE NOTE:**

All applicants who meet minimum requirements and return all documents by the deadline will be scheduled for the aptitude test. Letters are mailed at the end of October or the beginning of November with the aptitude test date and time.

There is a fee for this course. You can choose not to purchase the textbook and/or calculator. (These items can be found online at a lower price.)

In order to qualify for an oral interview, an applicant must obtain a minimum score of "4" or higher, using the electrical trade's aptitude test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research. The number of qualified applicants interviewed may be determined by selecting the top aptitude scorers equaling 500% of the anticipated positions available. You are not guaranteed an interview.

Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants must be at least 18 years of age.

Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants will be required to provide results of a physical examination and drug tests, which include testing for marijuana, as determined by the JATC.
